

### Pro Series Leaning Post Included Hardware Identification





As you plan to install the Fishmaster Pro Series Leaning Post, keep in mind that drilling into the deck of the boat is needed in order to safely secure the leaning post to the boat.


#### STEP 1: Install the Pro Series Leaning Post Seat Platform to Leg Bases



- 1. Position leg bases with foot rest attachment aligned and facing each other.
- 2. Place seat platform on top of leg bases while aligning holes on the top of the leg bases.
- **3.** Secure platform to leg bases with 6 M10 x 22 bolts from the underside of the leg bases with 6mm allen wrench. Tighten firmly.




### STEP 2: Install the Pro Series Leaning Post Foot Rest to Leaning Post Assembly




1. Insert foot rest with notch

- 2. Secure foot rest to Leaning Post assembly using two M10 Shoulder Bolts with 6mm allen wrench. Tighten firmly.
- **3.** Gently tap the Roll Pins into the small holes beneath the bolt-holes on each side of the Leaning Post foot rest using a rubber mallet.

### STEP 3: Install the Pro Series Leaning Post Seat Hinge Brackets to Seat Cushion




- 1. Place seat platform upside down on firm surface.
- 2. Position both seat hinge brackets in position as shown.

Ensure that the faces of the brackets are parallel to outside padding of the seat.

- Insert M6 x 20 bolt into each location with only a few turns just to get each started.
- After all four bolts are in position, tighten each bolts firmly with 6mm allen wrench.


#### STEP 4: Install the Pro Series Leaning Post Seat Cushion to Leaning Post Assembly



# STEP 5: Install the Pro Series Leaning Post Snap Screw to Leaning Post Assembly




1. Keep your leaning post seat secured by installing the included seat strap screw to the back of the leaning post frame. Use a permanent marker to mark the location where the buckle at the end of the seat strap comes in contact with the leaning post frame. Drill a pilot hole with a 1/8" drill bit and screw in the snap screw – the seat strap can now be secured until you need to lift it up.








STEP 6 DELUXE: Install the Pro Series Leaning Post backrest Frame to Backrest Upholstery


## **Deluxe Backrest Option**

- Place backrest frame on top of backrest upholstery while lining up bolt holes.
- 2. Insert M6 x 55 bolt through M6 washer and into each location with only a few turns of bolt to get each bolt started.
- 3. After all four bolts are in position, tighten each bolt firmly with 6mm allen wrench.
- Insert three cupholders into the cupholder inserts on frame back assembly. (This step is not shown.)










The Pro Series Leaning Post can be upgraded with a Deluxe Backrest featuring four rod holders and three cup holders.


#### STEP 8: Install the Pro Series Leaning Post Seat Assembly to Boat





**CAUTION:** If you are unfamiliar with your boat's construction, please seek professional advice before drilling holes.

- Locate the fuel tank, steering cables, and other critical boat components to ensure their safety when drilling.
- 2. Measure from the rear of your center console to the aft of your boat and place a tape line as a guide for where the front of the base plates will be mounted. Leaning posts are commonly installed at 15" to 20" back from the console, but this can be adjusted for your own comfort and specific boat requirements.



Pro Tip: We recommend positioning the leaning post so that there is adequate standing room with the footrest in the down position.

This will ensure comfort for both the captain and any accompanying passengers who wish to sit atop

the leaning post.

- 3. Position your leaning post on the deck and measure from the outside of each screw hole in the base plate to the side walls of your boat. This will help ensure the leaning post is centered on the deck of the boat and facing straight towards the bow.
- 4. Once in position, use a permanent marker to mark the screw hole positions on both leaning post base plates.
- 5. At each marked location, drill in reverse approximately 3/8" deep through the gel coat. Switch the drill to its standard rotation and finish drilling the hole through the deck.



CAUTION: Starting each hole with your drill in reverse is necessary to prevent spider cracking of the gel coat finish.

- Once all holes are drilled, use a 45° chamfer bit with the drill in reverse to countersink the screw holes.
- Drill one of the provided deck screws into each hole and remove it to thread the holes.
- 8. Use 3M 5200 Marine Adhesive in each of the screw holes as well as on the bottom of the base plate for added strength and durability.
- 9. Carefully set the leaning post on the prepared mounting surface matching up the newly drilled holes in the deck of the boat with those in the leaning post base plates.
- 10. Install the six deck screws to complete your installation.



CAUTION: Before using your leaning post, allow time for the adhesive to cure to the 3M rec<sup>™</sup>ommendations.
